**April 26, 2008** - Albany, NY – The Albany Conquest scored 27 fourth quarter points to pull away from the visiting Mahoning Valley Thunder en route to a 61-49 victory at the Times Union Center on Saturday. Albany recorded back-to-back touchdowns early in the fourth quarter, allowing the Conquest to record their third straight win and



The Thunder scored the only points of the third quarter to turn a 34-21 Albany advantage into a 35-34 Mahoning lead. The Conquest turned it around early in the fourth when WR Antwun Williams caught his third of four touchdowns just over a minute into the fourth quarter. Mahoning answered shortly thereafter before Williams added a 45-yard bomb to put Albany ahead 49-42. WR Chris Bocage extended the lead moments later and the Conquest never looked back.

Albany started the game quickly with three touchdowns in the first five minutes for a 20-7 advantage. The teams traded touchdowns into the second quarter and Conquest backup QB Joe Deluise rushed in the final score of the first half to make the score 34-21 after 30 minutes,
